



Camps Running Bear and Dancing Bear

Monkton, MD

General information:

- 228 acres of forest land, in the Gunpowder Conservancy, on the Gunpowder River
- *Camp Dancing Bear*: Open April 1- Nov. 20 (upper camp)
 - Large pavilion
 - Campfire circle, GaGa Pit, xylophone, Volleyball Ct, Monkey Bars
 - Boys' and girls' bathrooms and showers
 - One cabin (sleeps six)
 - Large grass playing field (or tent camping)
 - Fresh drinking water
 - Several Swings
 - Ample parking
 - Access to hiking trails
- *Camp Running Bear*: Open year-round (lower camp)
 - Dining Hall (heated) with full kitchen, seats 100, fireplace
 - Nature Lodge with fireplace
 - 5 cabins – sleep 8-10 each
 - Ample parking and tent camping available in field
 - Rope swings and chair swings; GaGa Pit; Xylophone
 - Small campfire ring (50); Large campfire ring with large grill (200)
 - Full bathroom available April 1-Nov. 20, with showers
 - Latrine (winter use)
- Hiking trails – miles of maintained trails
- Ropes Courses – low and high (must utilize certified instructor)
- Disc Golf Course – new as of March 2022 – 9 holes
- River access – ¾ mile along riverfront
- Orienteering Course, Yoga Nature Trail: 2 Eagle Scout Projects
- Over 22 Eagle Scout projects to date and 3 Gold Award Projects
