



## Camp Rental Rates -Running and Dancing Bear

Camp Running Bear and Dancing Bear are beautiful natural settings on the Gunpowder River only 10 minutes north of Hunt Valley, MD. The land has been used for 85 years to provide recreational opportunities for young people, churches, Boy Scouts, and Girl Scouts. Our original investment in 2008 was \$1,000,000 and over \$100,000 additional funds have been added since to modernize the Dining Hall.

The Camps are a great work in progress and our goal is to provide an exceptional experience for your groups any time of the year. Scout groups have undertaken very innovative projects to improve the site for all who come to enjoy it. We welcome Eagle and Girl Scout Gold projects! Call Al for ideas of what you can do to donate time and effort to enhancing the camp.

### Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, and Youth Groups

All groups must have adequate supervision. (one adult per five campers) We proudly provide you with this great outdoor facility, but we assume no responsibility for the safety of your campers and staff. An extra charge will be assessed for the use of the heating system in the dining hall if used by your group.



#### Camp Running Bear (formerly Camp ALKOR)

Includes use of 5 cabins (each sleeps 9), field for tent camping, 2 fire circles, Dining Hall with full kitchen, Nature Lodge, bathhouse (in-season) and latrines (all year), all trails, low ropes course and high ropes course. (\*with a certified instructor- extra charge)

#### Rates for any age (child-adult)

\$17 for one night per person

\$25 for two nights per camper



### Camp Dancing Bear (formerly Camp KALOR)

Includes use of pavilion, picnic tables, field for tent camping, bathrooms (in season), water access via well pump, all trails, fire circle, volleyball court, low ropes course and high ropes course (with a certified instructor\*extra charge). GaGa pit, and climbing/exercise equipment.

\$ 14 for one night per person

\$20 for two nights per person

Camps Running and Dancing Bear have miles of marked trails and access to the Gunpowder River. Maps available upon request. Orienteering Course for Scouts, Yoga Fitness trail, Disc Golf Course and a GaGa Pit are available.

Note: The bathhouse and bathrooms are only available during the spring, summer, and fall seasons. A latrine is available at Camp Running Bear during the winter months.

**Note:** Both camps are **leave no trace facilities**. Bring **trash bags** and **remove all trash** before leaving. Clean-up your area and leave it like you would like to find it.

Rates are for all attendees, no freebies.
